STEPS TO COMPLETE THE GENERAL EXHIBITS SCHOLARSHIP:

1. Complete the scholarship application
2. Complete the references after getting permission to use their name
3. Complete the required essay – Must be typed in a 12 font
4. Optional – add a resume
5. Sign the application
6. Have your FFA, FCCLA or 4H leader sign the application
7. Secure all required paperwork together in the above order and turn in to your leader.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS WILL BE SCORED ON THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

1. Academic achievement – 12 points
2. Clubs & organization participation – 12 points
3. Years entered items in the General Exhibits Divisions and awards won – 20 points
4. Work and/or community volunteer work – 36 points
5. Essay – 20 points
6. Inclusion of a resume will be considered in final score
