### Division Rules:

*All entries are subject to the General Rules and these additional rules.*

**NO straw bedding allowed anywhere on grounds! No shaving pellets in sheep or goat pens.**

**OWNERSHIP:** Goats must be validated (ear-tagged) with an official State Validation Tag on October 23 or October 30, 2025, from 5:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m. Does must have been continuously cared for and fed personally by exhibitor since tag in date through show.

This division is open to any breed or crossbreed.

Breeding does do not have to be registered to be shown. Teeth and teats will not be taken into consideration for show.

A current validation tag must be present in the ear of all does at all times.

Minimum weight will be 50 lbs. Maximum weight will be 120 lbs. Does will show by weight, not by age. For goats over the maximum or under the minimum weight, only one reweigh will be allowed prior to end of weigh in.

If horned, the horns must be tipped (not less than the diameter of a dime at the end). **NO DEHORNING ALLOWED ON GROUNDS.**

Grooming: Length of hair is left to the discretion of the exhibitor. **No adhesives, no false hair, no paint.**

All breeding does must be shown off the chain or halter. No bracing allowed.

### Division Awards:

Ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> place

Awards will be based on number of entries, decided by superintendent. Divisions will be chosen with divisional winners competing for Grand and Reserve Champion and Bronze Medallion Doe Goat Honors.
